RESOLUTION 10-15

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE WATER RATES FOR RESIDENTIAL, BUSINESS AND SCHOOL WATER USERS UNDER CITY CODE 8-1-8 3C AND ALL AMENDMENTS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Seneca, has determined that it is in the City of Seneca's public health, safety and welfare that each RESIDENTIAL Water user rate be:

- ➤ \$41.00 for water and service provided by the City's water system
- > \$5.00 for non-active connection to the City's water system (properties with meter)
- > \$10.00 for seasonal maintenance between the months of May-September. This includes lot upkeep for appearance and safety only, no sewer use authorized

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Seneca, has determined that it is in the City of Seneca's public health, safety and welfare that each BUSINESS Water user rate be:

- ➤ \$43.00 for water and service provided by the City's water system;
- > \$5.00 for non-active connection to the City's water system (properties with meter)

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Seneca, has determined that it is in the City of Seneca's public health, safety and welfare that each SCHOOL Water user rate be \$43.00 for water and service provided by the City's water system;

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Seneca has determined it is necessary to set the RESIDENTIAL, BUSINESS AND SCHOOL water rates as stated herein to aid in compensating the City for its expenses associated with supplying water service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Seneca that the above noted findings are adopted and:

- > RESIDENTIAL water rates are now \$41.00,
- ➤ BUSINESS water rates are now \$43.00
- ➤ NON-ACTIVE connection rates are now \$5.00
- > SEASONAL MAINTENANCE rates are now \$10.00
- > SCHOOL water rates are now \$43.00

for water and service provided by the City's water system.

This Resolution shall become effective August 1, 2015.
